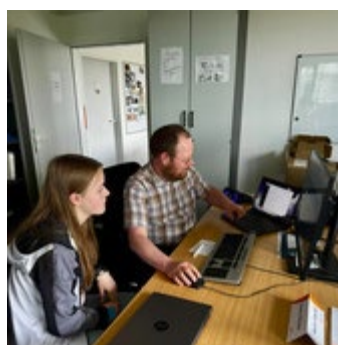

We will be in **Nuremberg** from **October 27 to 29**.

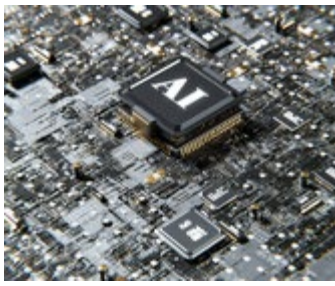

AI as a Pawn in the Struggle to Advance National Interests

Access to powerful AI models is increasingly becoming a geopolitical issue. Following a directive from the U.S. government to block the Claude Fable 5 and Claude Mythos 5 models for non-U.S. citizens, Anthropic has suspended access to these models entirely, as it is difficult to determine a user's nationality.

This development once again highlights the enormous importance of strengthening digital sovereignty and the existence of European and open-source AI models.
